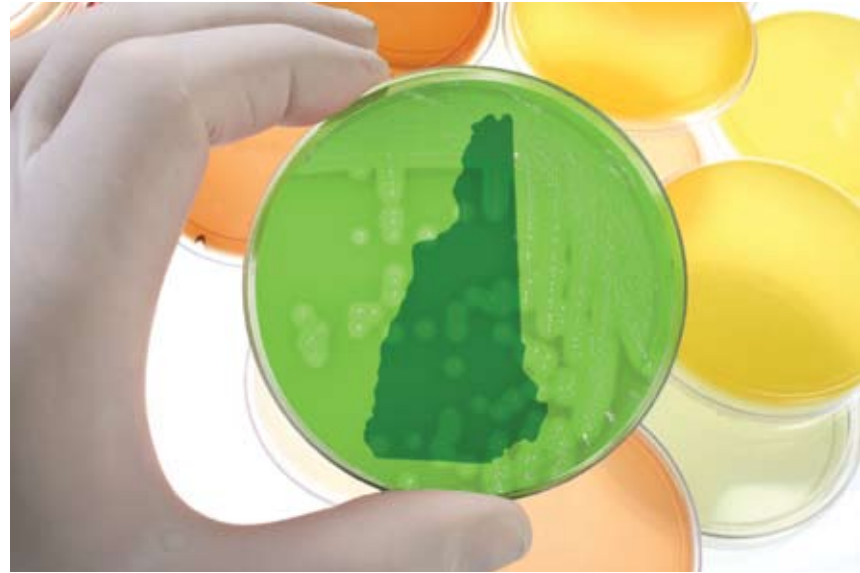
Thank you for becoming a member of the New Hampshire Bio/Medical Council.

The NH Bio/Medical Council promotes economic development in New Hampshire through our commitment to education, business development, and job creation.

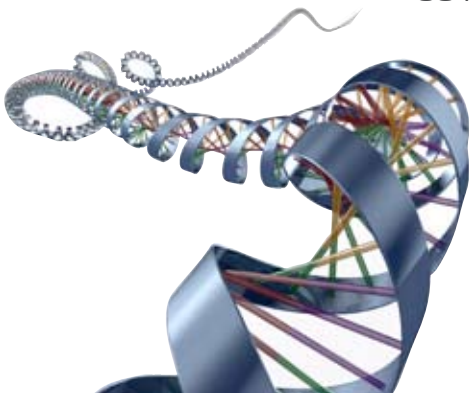
